

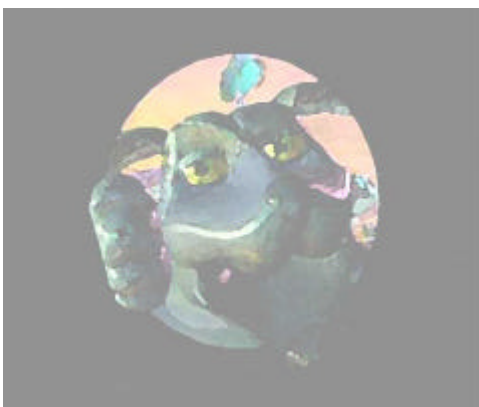
Educational “Drugworld” Kit

The educational “Drugworld” Kit suitcase is an educative tool useful for drug-use prevention programs working with adolescents between the ages of 16 and 18, and is a possible universal tool that works within the set guidelines.

The kit is an attractive and dynamic tool that attempts to create an open dialogue about drug use by offering different methods, materials and activities for educators and the youth community alike.

The kit contains:

- A guide booklet of presentation where the introduction describes the statement of purpose, objectives and goals of the program, the methodology of its work and creation, as well as the necessary materials for the curriculum that make up the suitcase.
- Instruction materials for the instructor which includes information about the development of the activities for the students in the program (12 informative index cards)
- Teaching booklet guide for the instructor, with information regarding drug dependency, addiction and use as well as preventative measures and methods of action.
- Additional interactive instruction material (Video Drugworld and CD Rom)



It is important to notice the innovative resource this kit can be, because of the ways in which our program attempts to approach and teach young adults about drugs as well as all the possibilities the kit offers in its realistic educative endeavours for the “adolescent reality”.

Drugworld Video

Drugworld is a 3-D computer animated short between 4 and 5 minutes long about drug-use, dependence, addiction and its prevention. The story is an adaptation from english to spanish created by young adults with the supervision of professionals and experts in the field of drug prevention.

This film is a tool that attempts to visually connect adolescents in a fun and innovative way to desensitize them to this issue, and further create a more understanding and open dialogue about drugs. The "Drugworld" video uses irony and a fast paced rhythm, in the pretense of characters being in an amusement park with situations confronting habitual drug use (of different substances) and dangerous situations associated with contacting HIV/AIDS and violent behavior.



CD ROM

This CD-ROM has been created as an additional resource material to the rest of the activities presented in the suitcase kit.

It is an interactive educative material specifically for the adolescents, where they can learn and put to use the knowledge they are receiving through the program.

The CD-ROM is structured to provide information about:

- Different kinds of drugs
- Contains an interactive adventure about drug prevention
- The goals and objective of the Side-b program
- Directions and information materials of cultural interest.
